


Kennedy Park Trail Map

Badger Lake is a 45 acre man-made impoundment, stocked with large mouth bass, crappie, channel catfish, bluegill, and northern pike.

- No gas motors allowed
- Boat ramp and fishing docks provided

- Swimming beach (no lifeguard on duty)
