


Camp Kennedy Park!

## Camping

The Kennedy Park Campground offers large, shaded sites for all

types of camping from the weekend tent camper to the full-time camper.

- 100 Camping Sites
  - 1-29 (sewer, water, electricity)
  - 30-79 (electricity only)
  - 80-100 (campsite only)
- Handicapped accessible restroom/shower facility
- Firewood is available at scheduled times ( 5 logs per \$1.00 )
- Camp Host (May - Sept.)
- Playground
- Sunday Church Service
- Pets allowed, but must be on a leash and supervised



## Badger Lake

Badger Lake is a 45 acre man-made impoundment, stocked with large-mouth bass, crappie, channel catfish, bluegill, and northern pike.

- No Gas Motors Allowed
- Boat Ramp and Fishing Docks Provided
- Handicapped Accessible Fishing Jetty
- Swimming Beach (No lifeguard on duty)
