Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to the *Care for Kids* Program! This program is for children from birth through 20 years of age who are enrolled in Medicaid (Title 19). The program pays for regular medical and dental checkups. It also covers treatment for health problems identified during the checkups. There is NO COST for these services for children who have a current Medicaid (Title 19) card.

*Care for Kids* services include:

- \*Well Child exams (Medical checkups)
- \*Dental checkups
- \*Vision and hearing tests
- \*Nutrition information
- \*Immunizations (shots)
- \*Transportation to these services

Medical checkups are recommended at the following ages:

*Newborn	*9 Month	*3 Years	*10 Years	*20 Years
*1 Month	*12 Months	*4 Years	*12 Years	
*2 Months	*15 Months	*5 Years	*14 Years	
*4 Months	*18 Months	*6 Years	*16 Years	
*6 Months	*2 Years	*8 Years	*18 Years	

Checkups can be used for enrollment in day-care centers, school, Head Start, and sports programs.

If you don't have a doctor or dentist, we can help you find one and schedule appointments. We can also give you information about WIC, food bank, energy assistance, parenting programs, immunizations, and more.

If you are pregnant, breastfeeding, or have children 5 years of age or under, you may qualify for the WIC Program. This program will provide food items such as eggs, cheese, milk, cereal, juice, bread, baby food, formula, and etc. for your family. Please call Jen at 574-3802 to see if you qualify for WIC.
