

**BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S Regular Meeting**  
**May 21, 2013 - 10:00a.m. Board of Supervisors' Room**  
**Webster County Courthouse**

The Board of Supervisors met in Session on the above date with the following members present: Singer, Fletcher, Dencklau and Leffler. Absent: Campbell.

Moved by Fletcher, seconded by Dencklau to approve minutes of the May 14, 2013 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to receive and place on file the following Drainage Repairs: D.D.#28, D.D.#253, D.D.#291 and D.D.#320. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Fletcher to approve promotion of David Kraft from Correctional Officer to Correctional Sergeant increasing his wage fifty cents per hour effective May 22, 2013. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Fletcher, seconded by Dencklau to approve hiring and employment of Lacey M. Utley, Family Support Worker effective May 28, 2013 at the rate of \$12.00 per hour per recommendation of Kari Prescott, Director of Public Health. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Fletcher, seconded by Dencklau to approve temporary road closure of South River Road from 230<sup>th</sup> Street north to Avenue O in Fort Dodge for sewage treatment plant improvements). Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to approve the following resolution:

**SPEED LIMIT ON RIVERDALE DRIVE**

**WHEREAS**, the Webster County Board of Supervisors is empowered under the authority of Sections 321.255 and 321.285 of the Code of Iowa, to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

**WHEREAS**, such an engineering and traffic investigation has been completed by the Webster County Engineer, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Webster County Board of Supervisors that speed limit be established and appropriate signs be erected as follows:

25 MPH on Riverdale Drive from Madison Avenue east to dead end

This speed limit shall be effective when the traffic control signs are erected.

**ERECTING STOP SIGN FOR NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC ON MADISON AVENUE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under the authority of Sections 321.236 and 321.255 and 321.345 of the Code of Iowa to designate any highway under their jurisdiction as a through highway and to designate any intersection as a stop intersection and to erect the signs at one or more entrances to such intersection, and

**WHEREAS**, the "T" intersection at the junction of Madison Avenue and 180<sup>th</sup> Street common to Sections 12 and 13, T89N, R29W, Douglas Township and Sections 7 and 18, T89N, R28W, Cooper Township is currently not controlled by any regulatory signs, and

**WHEREAS**, present traffic would be better served if the northbound approach on Madison Avenue was made the STOP approach to the intersection, and the east and west approaches on 180<sup>th</sup> Street were designated as through approaches, due to terrain, vegetation and development, which limit sight distance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Webster County Board of Supervisors that a STOP sign be erected in the Northwest Corner of Section 18, T89N, R28W, Cooper Township for northbound traffic on Madison Avenue approaching 180<sup>th</sup> Street

This resolution shall be in effect when the traffic control signs are erected.
