The Board of Supervisors met in Session on the above date with the following members present: Singer, Fletcher, Campbell, and Leffler. Absent: Dencklau.

Moved by Fletcher, seconded by Campbell to approve minutes of the August 20, 2013 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Campbell, seconded by Leffler to receive and place on file the following Drainage Repairs: D.D.#30, D.D.#113 and D.D.#1. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Fletcher to approve and authorize Chair to sign Asbestos Survey and Certification of Abatement Contract Amendment #2 (Flood Buyout Program property at 2201 160th Street) increasing contract \$90.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Fletcher, seconded by Campbell to approve and authorize Chair to sign Asbestos Survey and Certification of Abatement Contract Amendment #3 (Flood Buyout Program property at 2209 160th Street) increasing contract \$30.00 and Amendment #4 (Flood Buyout Program property at 2009 Nathan Avenue) increasing contract \$30.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Campbell, seconded by Leffler to approve temporary road closure on 300th Street between Adams and Baxter Avenues for bridge replacement. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Fletcher to approve the following Proclamation

Addiction Recovery Month Proclamation

WHEREAS, behavioral health is an essential part of health and one's overall wellness; and

WHEREAS, prevention of mental and/or substance use disorders works, treatment is effective, and people recover in our area and around the nation; and

WHEREAS, preventing and overcoming mental and/or substance use disorders is essential to achieving healthy lifestyles, both physically and emotionally; and

WHEREAS, we must encourage relatives and friends of people with mental and/or substance use disorders to implement preventive measures, recognize the signs of a problem, and guide those in need to appropriate treatment and recovery support services; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, 3.8 million people received specialty treatment for a substance use disorder and more than 31.6 million adults aged 18 or older received services for mental disorders, according to the 2011 National Survey on Drug Use and Health. Given the serious nature of this public health problem, we must continue to reach the millions more who need help; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2013 as a result of the Affordable Care Act, more than 11 million uninsured individuals with behavioral health needs will become eligible for affordable insurance coverage for their treatment needs, according to the 2011 National Survey on Drug Use and Health. We must encourage all of these individuals are enrolled into coverage; and

WHEREAS, to help more people achieve and sustain long-term recovery, the Webster County Board of Supervisors and Community and Family Resources invite all residents of Webster County to participate in National Recovery Month; and

NOW, THEREFORE, We, by virtue of the authority vested in us by the laws of Iowa, do hereby proclaim the month of September 2013 as National Recovery Month in Webster County and call upon the people of the County to observe this month with appropriate programs, activities, and ceremonies to support this year's Recovery Month.
