

BOARD OF SUPERVISOR'S Regular Meeting
March 29, 2016 - 10:00a.m. Board of Supervisors' Room

The Board of Supervisors met in Session on the above date with the following members present: Singer, Fletcher, Dencklau, Campbell and Leffler. Absent: None.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to approve minutes of the March 22, 2016 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Singer to receive and place on file Manure Management Annual Update for Hubbards in Section 3, Gowrie Township. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Fletcher to table Veterans Affairs Commission Report of Persons Served for period ending March 31, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Fletcher, seconded by Dencklau to approve request to assign Tax Sale Certificate P110006 (Real Estate Parcel #0718309002) to Anthony Pieczko Jr. for \$50.00 and he would be responsible for the costs associated with serving the notice of expiration. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Dencklau, seconded by Leffler to approve and authorize Chair to sign ten utility permit applications from Interstate Power & Light Company, Jefferson, Iowa for upgrading their electric transmission lines located in Dayton and Lost Grove Townships near Harcourt. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Leffler, seconded by Singer to approve setting public hearing on Fiscal Year 2017 Secondary Road Budget and Five Year Construction Program during the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors at 10:00a.m. Tuesday, April 12, 2016. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Singer, seconded by Fletcher to approve request from City of Dayton to establish detour on two miles of granular surfaced Quail Avenue, one mile of granular surfaced 380th Street, and one-half of paved surfaced Racine Avenue from approximately 9:30a.m. to 11:30a.m., Monday September 5, 2016 during Annual Dayton Labor Day Parade, subject to City of Dayton being responsible for coordinating and monitoring all necessary traffic control per Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Motion carried unanimously.

At 11:00a.m. an informal meeting for D.D.#69 Branch 1 & 2 was held to discuss whether to repair or improve tile lines. For further particulars see Drainage Record Book.
